Original contributions (along with an abstract of 200-300 words) not published elsewhere may be submitted to the Chief Editor (Director General, BISS)/Editor in duplicate, typed double-spaced, normally within about 6,000 words. Footnotes should be placed at the bottom of the page following the styles (The Chicago Manual of Style — 17<sup>th</sup> Edition) given below:

### **For Books**

First name Last name, *Title of Book: Subtitle of Book* (Place of Publication: Publisher, Year of Publication), Page numbers.

### **Example:**

Cheryl Strayed, *Wild: From Lost to Found on the Pacific Crest Trail* (New York: Alfred A. Knopf, 2012), 87-88.

### **For Chapters in Books**

First name Last name, "Chapter Name," in *Title of Book*, Name of Editor (Place of Publication: Publisher, Year), Page numbers.

### **Example:**

Glenn Gould, "Streisand as Schwarzkopf," in *The Glenn Gould Reader*, ed. Tim Page (New York: Vintage Books, 1984), 310.

### **For Documents**

Department/Agency, *Title* (Place of Publication: Publisher, Year), URL if found online.

### **Example:**

Defense Acquisition University, *Defense Acquisition Guidebook* (Fort Belvoir: Defense Acquisition University, 2013), <https://dag.dau.mil>.

### **For Journal Articles**

First name Last name, "Title of Article," *Title of Journal* Volume no., no. of issue (Date of Publication): Page numbers, URL if found online.

### **Example:**

Bo-Chi Liu, "Beholding the Feminine Sublime: Lee Miller's War Photography," *Signs* 40, no. 2 (Winter 2015): 311, <https://doi.org/10.1086/678242>.

### **For Newspaper**

First name Last name, "Title of Article," *Title of Newspaper*, Date of Publication, Edition or Section if applicable, URL if found online.

### **Example:**

David G Savage, “Long Beach Police Investigating Fatal Shooting of Man at Homeless Encampment,” *Los Angeles Times*, January 30, 2022, <https://www.latimes.com/california/story/2022-01-30/homeless-man-shot-long-beach-investigation>.

### **General Websites —No Named Author**

“Title of Web Page” or Description of Web Page (website), Title or Description of the Site as a Whole, Owner or Sponsor of the Site, updated/last modified/accessed date, URL.

### **Example:**

“Apps for Office Sample Pack,” Office Dev Center, Microsoft Corporation, accessed October 20, 2015, [https://code.msdn.microsoft.com/office/Apps-for-Office-code-d\)4762b7](https://code.msdn.microsoft.com/office/Apps-for-Office-code-d)4762b7).

### **General Websites—Named Author**

First name Last name, “Title of Web Page” or Description of Web Page (website), Title or Description of the Site as a Whole, Owner or Sponsor of the Site, updated/last modified/accessed date, URL.

### **Example:**

Richard G Heck, Jr., “About the Philosophical Gourmet Report,” Richard Kimberly Heck, Last modified August 05, 2016, <http://rgheck.frege.otg/philosophy/aboutpgr.php>.

### **For Paper Presented in Seminar/ Workshop/ Conference**

First name Last name, “Title of Conference Paper,” (Paper presented at Name of Conference, Place of Conference, Month Year), Page numbers.

### **Example:**

Gary Templin, “Creation Stories of the Middle East,” (paper presented at Northwestern Annual Conference, Evanston, IL, April 26, 2000), 17.

### **For Repeated References**

Last name of the author(s), Main title of the work (usually shortened if more than four words), and page numbers.

### **Example:**

Reitz, Political Theory, 81.

Khan and Munira, “Poor Adaptation Finance,” 131-151.

Tables, maps and diagrams should be placed in separate sheets. Contributors are also requested to enclose a brief biographical note and contact address in separate sheets. Scripts submitted for publication are not returned. For book review, two copies of book should be sent to the Chief Editor.
